
Increasing SFTP Timeout Instructions


If SFTP connections to admin.dcollab.washington.edu do not complete due to timeout errors, you can adjust the default timeout settings for WinSCP and FileZilla.

WinSCP:


The timeout controls are specified for each connection. In the list of connections under the *Login* window, select the entry for admin.dcollab and click **Edit**.



Click Advanced....




In the *Connection* section, you will see the *Timeouts* section. Increase the value to 6000 (the maximum).




Click **OK** and then **Save**.

FileZilla:

Click **Edit** > **Settings...**.



In the *Settings* dialog, under the *Connection* setting, change the Timeout value to 0. This will disable the timeout, so as long as the server is functioning properly, a connection should eventually be made.



Click OK.
